We are not there yet. So what we do is buy imported organic black teas, green teas and rooibos tea from sources we trust and we have expanded beyond herbal teas. By buying our teas you support us to grow; to teach other farmers to grow herbs; to maintain our beautiful, peaceful and totally natural farm and to continue our health related classes.
